 - 3. Reserve funding is adequate for what we have; it has kept pace with growth.

- o 104% of the Revenue forecast, 93.5% of Expense forecast.
- Due to increased temperatures; utilities have been higher. Between the MCA and the District 70 Million gallons of water will be used during the summer months.
- Pools have hit capacity numbers several times this summer. The first time in history was July 4, 2012 at all four pools.
- o Assessments are still on schedule with anticipated growth as predicted.
- Collections are down 54% (a good thing), Attorney fees are down, and so collection policies/procedures are working.
- o Increased costs in signage for Aquatics and Events.
- o Retail sales up due to management of concessions.
- o End of year overall budget slightly ahead of what was budgeted.

V. CULTURAL ARTS CENTER

- Total estimate for entire project \$11.3 million which does not include water, sewer, office items (tables, chairs, moveable stage)
- It is being determined that there will need to be 'phases' to the project.
- Phase I is estimated at the \$8 million cost which includes 103 parking spaces, Multi Purpose rooms, Exhibit space and Administration space.
- Currently working with four outside cultural arts feasibility consultants to offer an independent analysis and comparison of the overall demand is from the community.
- Cultural Art Center meeting August 24 at Noon.

Facilities

• Have recently hired security to monitor pools due to recent vandalism.

<u>Aquatics</u>

- 98,000 visits of the four swimming pools.
- In 10 weeks there were over 3,000 participants in aquatic programs.
- 25% of our staff are Stapleton residents.

Events

- Have sold out of the three First Friday wine tasting events thus far. Still have two more, September 7 and October 5.
- Partnering with Central Park Recreation Center to offer 'Saturday Night Live,' the popular kids outing that takes place at the Recreation Center. Held once per month, the first event will take place on September 15.
- Movies and concert participation has been 1,500-2,000 people at each event.
- The Beer Festival maximum is 1,500 participants for the 2012 event; the current registration is at 775 tickets sold.
- The Denver Children's Home is the benefactor from the proceeds of Stapleton Rocks...a concert for a cause. This event is September 8, with 12 local bands.
- The 2nd Annual Stapleton Kids Triathlon took place on August 12 and had 237 participants that completed the race.
